Tennis Rules and Regulations

The Tennis Rules and Regulations of The Langham Huntington, Pasadena set forth herein have been developed to uphold and maintain the standards of the resort, to provide information and notice as to various aspects of the tennis facility and to provide for the enjoyment of the game of tennis by all of our members and guests.

A. Tennis Etiquette

Proper tennis etiquette must be observed at all times. Excessive noise, racquet throwing, profanity or other unsportsmanlike conduct will not be permitted. Such conduct may result in a player being asked to vacate the court.

Proper tennis attire must be worn at all times. Players must wear acceptable tennis shoes. Non-marking shoes must be worn on the hard courts. Cut-off shorts, Bermuda shorts, bathing suits, tank tops, are not permitted.

No skates, skateboards, bikes, or other riding toys permitted on the tennis courts. No game other than tennis allowed on the tennis courts.

No Smoking, gum, glass containers etc. allowed in the tennis court area. Players will properly dispose of all refuse before leaving the courts.

Use of Cell Phones should be at minimum and their use should be respectful of players on all courts.

B. Court Reservations & Rates

Tennis Court Hours:

- 7:00am through 9:00pm - Monday through Friday
- 7:00am to 6:00pm - Saturdays and Sunday

All players must register at the Front Desk before taking a court, even if a court has been previously assigned.

Courts may be reserved 7 (seven) days in advance by Members and guests for one and one-half (1 ½) hours for singles and doubles play. There will be no automatic reservations for future days, and no courts may be reserved for more than one and one-half (1 ½) hours. .

No player or group of players may reserve a court for more than one and one half (1 ½) hours of continuous play.

If unable to keep your reserved court time, please notify the Front Desk. A fifteen (15) minute grace period beyond your scheduled court time will be allowed. Failure to show up for court time within the fifteen (15) minute grace period will result in forfeiture of the court if other members are waiting and no other courts are available.
