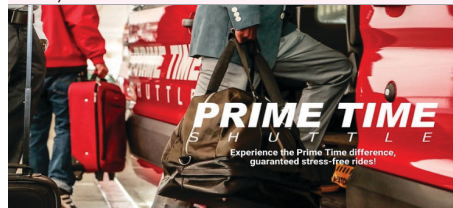


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Second Sunday of every month

A center for art, culture and learning since 1924, the museum was built by pioneering collector and entrepreneur Grace Nicholson (1877-1948) as her residence, galleries, and treasure emporium. Her championing of Asian art set the tone for much of Pasadena's arts-related activities during the ensuing decades. It was also once the site of the Pasadena Art Museum, which was known for its groundbreaking exhibitions of contemporary art.
