A CALIFORNIA ICON

Welcome to The Langham Huntington, Pasadena. We're delighted you have chosen to stay with us and we look forward to familiarizing you with highlights of our hotel's rich history.

The Langham Huntington, Pasadena has provided memories for millions of guests in a tradition of luxury and elegance for over 100 years. The hotel was founded in 1907 as the Hotel Wentworth, but was forced to close after six months due to a lack of operating funds. In 1911, railroad tycoon and art collector Henry Huntington purchased the Hotel Wentworth, renaming it the Huntington Hotel. Huntington hired prominent Los Angeles architect Myron Hunt to redesign the main building and grounds. It reopened in 1914 as the Huntington Hotel, transformed into a beautiful winter resort and it has continued to flourish as an iconic landmark ever since.

Henry Huntington hired D.M. Linnard as the first manager of the hotel. An experienced hotelier, Linnard bought the hotel from Huntington in 1917 and in 1924 he turned the management of the hotel over to his son-in-law, Stephen W. Royce. Under his 45 year management, the hotel flourished despite the lean years of the Depression and World War II. Royce added California's first outdoor Olympic size swimming pool in 1926.

Inspired by Lucerne, Switzerland's Kappelbrücke Bridge, Royce commissioned resident landscape artist Frank Moore to paint pictures depicting California scenes to adorn the property's 228 foot redwood bridge's gables. The paintings took a year to complete and were unveiled in March 1933. Rehabilitated and restored in 2020, the landmark is considered America's only covered Picture Bridge, displaying over 40 reproductions of Frank Moore's original oil paintings over a gabled roof.

In 1954, Stephen Royce sold the hotel to the Sheraton Corporation. The hotel continued operating until 1985 when it was forced to close because of its inability to meet earthquake structural standards. By special election, Pasadena's residents voted on a historic preservation initiative to demolish and fully rebuild the hotel to meet safety standards; this work began in 1987 and allowed the hotel to fully reopen by 1991 with its original footprint intact. Today The Huntington Hotel remains an icon of Pasadena's rich history and an integral party of the community.

Visitors may recognize the property from its starring role as a backdrop for film and television since the silent movie era. From "Saving Mr. Banks" to "The Parent Trap" to "Melrose Place" and many more, it continues to be one of the city's most recognized film locations.

The Royce | Wood-Fired Steakhouse

The Tap Room bar and lounge features hand-crafted cocktails, a unique wine selection, premium artisanal beers on tap from around the world and upscale bar bites. The bar includes stylish flexible seating, a fireplace with a surrounding "living room" and cozy couches, beautiful mahogany paneling and pillars, and a spectacular lounge-like outdoor patio offering beautiful vistas of The Langham's Horseshoe Garden and San Marino.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Emergency Contact Number: 66*

The Langham Huntington, Pasadena is committed to taking every measure to ensure guest safety. We are equipped with a fire life safety system including smoke detectors, sprinklers, fire alarms, visual strobes, and a public address system. A 24 hour Loss Prevention Department is ready to assist with guest safety and security needs. In case of an emergency, please dial 66* to reach Loss Prevention. A plan showing your nearest evacuation route and emergency exit is situated on the back of your guestroom door. Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with this plan.

Fire

In the unlikely event of a fire, please remain calm. If you are in your room and detect a fire, leave the area immediately, dial 66*, and report the location to Loss Prevention. Do not use the elevator when vacating the area. Take the nearest safe stairs which are clearly marked with exit signs, head downwards to the bottom floor, and proceed through the Emergency Exit.

If you are in your room and detect a fire outside the door, safely test the door to make sure it is not hot. If the door is hot, do not exit. Remain in your room, stay calm, and dial 66*.

If smoke should start to enter your room, seal off the door by placing wet towels or sheets at the bottom. Turn off your air conditioning unit. Fill your bathtub with water in order to maintain the moist cloths that are keeping the smoke out. Dial 66* and report your location. In the event of a fire, our fire life safety system will activate an alarm, and our Loss Prevention staff will provide further instruction via the public address system.

Earthquake

If an earthquake occurs, look for the safest place and carefully move towards it, and remain calm. If you are inside the hotel, do not go outside. Seek cover under a sturdy table or desk, or crouch against an interior wall. Avoid windows, mirrors, other glass objects and tall furniture. If you are in bed, stay there and bring pillows and covers over your entire body for protection. Do not use elevators.

After an earthquake occurs, do not panic or rush outside. Do not light matches, candles, or cigarettes. Protect your hands and feet from debris and broken objects. Be prepared for aftershocks, and await instructions from hotel staff.
